Dear Mr. President,
Dear Board Members,
Ladies and Gentlemen,

As a Vice-President of JJIF and Head of the Department of Self-defence for the Army, Police, Security Companies and the Public, I am pleased to present to your attention the Annual Activity Report of the Department for 2014.

This year was dynamic and active for the Department.

1. In January, 2014 in Sofia – Bulgaria we organized a work meeting with the JJIF General Manager – Mr. Eugene Domagata. During the meeting we discussed the Strategy and tactics in the area of self-defence and the work plan of the Department for 2014.
2. In February 2014 we organized two events:
 - In Mexico a Pan-American seminar on self-defence took place. The interest in the discussed themes was very great. Over 80 participants attended the seminar. The training was implemented by the JJIF Vice Presidents Dr. Tomo Borissoff and Mr. Igor Lanzoni, the General Manager Mr. Domagata and the Technical Director

for Latin America Mr. Eusebio Sanchez. The President of the Mexican Ju-jitsu Federation, Mr. Adolfo Castorena, provided active support for the organization of the seminar. The President of JJIF Mr. P.Theodoropoulos also participated in the seminar.

The Strategy and tactics in the area of self-defence and the work plan of the Department prepared for 2014 have been presented to the JJIF President and have been discussed by the Board members who were present in Mexico.

- The second event took place in Loano, Italy. A practical training seminar on self-defence has been organized with the active support of the President of the Italian Ju-jitsu Federation Mr. Dario Quenza. Over 40 persons participated in the seminar. The training was implemented by the JJIF Vice Presidents Dr. Tomo Borissov and Mr. Igor Lanzoni and by the General Manager Mr. Domagata.
3. On 27th March 2014 representatives of the JJIF Management visited the College of Economics and Administration in Plovdiv (Bulgaria). The JJIF President presented to the students the strategic priorities of the Federation concerning the role of Ju Jitsu in the education and training of the young generations. He paid special attention to the opportunities for partnership between JJIF and the universities in the training of the students. Mr. Domagata stressed on the social, moral and health aspects of the impact of the training in self-defence of any person, regardless of the age. The JJIF Vice-president, Dr. Tomo Borissov spoke to the students about the activities of the Department of Self-defence for the army, the police, the security companies and the public.
 4. In Abu Dhabi during the World Professional Jiu-Jitsu Championship (in April 2014) we had meeting with the AUJJ Mr. Abdulmunem Al

Hashmi. He has been provided with the profile of the Department. Attention has been paid to the training in both areas - self-defence for the public and for the personnel working in the security sector. A concept on the possibilities for work of the Department in Asia has been elaborated after the visit in Abu Dhabi. The Concept has been provided to the AUJJ President.

5. In July 2014 the European Police and Fire Games took place in Brussels. The Department of Self-defence for the army, the police, the security companies and the public participated actively in the preparation for participation. In the event participated over 30 ju-jitsu competitors from 8 countries – Azerbaijan, Belgium, Bulgaria, France, Germany, Netherlands, Russia and Spain. The JJIF General Secretary and the President of the Belgian Ju-jitsu Federation provided organizational support to all participants.
6. In August 2014 the First JJIF Convention took place. The Department participated actively in the organization and the activities of the Self-defence Work Group. Two Commissions have been organized – Commission for Self-defence for the Personnel working in the Police, Army and Security companies and Commission for Self Defence for All. The participants exchanged ideas and learned about the German, French and Bulgarian experience and good practices in the area of Self-defence for All.
7. In 2014 the JJIF Vice-President T. Borissov continued to promote the JJIF activities by giving the celebrities honorary Ju-jitsu Dans. In March 2014, during his visit in Bulgaria, the famous Hollywood Star Pierce Brosnan has received such honorary Dan as well.
