Class U18 - Aspirants girls:	-40, -44, -48, -52, -57, -63, -70, 70+.
Class U21 - Junior boys:	-56, -62, -69, -77, -85, -94, 94+.
Class U21 - Junior girls:	-49, -55, -62, -70, 70+.
Class Senior men:	-62, -69, -77, -85, -94, 94+.
Class Senior women:	-55, -62, -70, 70+.

Duo System series:

Class Cadets:	series 1, 2, 3, three by referee call
Class Aspirants:	all series, 3 calls by referee
Class Junior:	all series, 3 calls by referee
Class Seniors:	all series, 3 calls by referee

Ne-waza system:

Depending on the amount of registrations, categories will be performed depending we work with regular- or a Poule system.

Weight classes according the IJJF regulations!

Competitors are supposed to own/take with them red and blue belts (obi's).

Depending of age mouth protection is required.

Class Senior men:	-62, -69, -77, -85, -94, 94+.
Class Senior women:	-55, -62, -70, 70+.
