



## WADA FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

Dear friends,

Pursuant to the latest WADA requirements, in order for JJIF and its Continental Unions to remain WADA-compliant, a series of new financial commitments will have to be addressed.

WADA requires that JJIF joins a complete anti-doping program, coordinated by WADA specialists, whose estimated annual value is 100,000 USD. This program will ensure that enough anti-doping tests are performed during the World and Continental Championships, the international JJIF-approved tournaments, as well as out-of-competition.

The JJEU will have to cover approximately 20% of this amount. This amount will be spread as follows: 3,000 USD per European Championship (seniors + U18 & U21) and 1,000 USD per JJIF Grand Slam event organized in Europe (Paris + Balkan + German).

While we understand that the additional financial burden is very heavy, we know that only by remaining fully WADA-compliant can the JJIF (and its Continental Unions) preserve its position in the IWGA and our participation in the coming World Games.

The JJEU Board proposes to the General Assembly the following options, to be decided on during the meeting in Gliwice, Poland:

- project fee, per event, collected from all member NFs
- anti-doping fee per participating athlete in each respective event
