4. INSURANCE

Each National Federation is responsible for its competitors (the control of non-pregnancy as well as the gender control are placed under the responsibility of the National Federations) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials, during the JUJITSU GRAND PRIX PARIS 2022.

The organizer of the JUJITSU GRAND PRIX PARIS 2022 and the JJIF will not be responsible for any insurance related to the above mentioned matters. Nevertheless the National Judo Jujitsu Federation staging the JUJITSU GRAND PRIX PARIS 2022 shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.

The organizer of the JUJITSU GRAND PRIX PARIS 2022 and the JJIF has no liability for any claims of injury, illness or death arising out of the participation and traveling in connection with these events.

5. REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Registration for this event must be made via Sport ID : https://www.sportdata.org/ju-jitsu/set-online/veranstaltung_info_main.php?active_menu=calendar&vernrr=339#a_eventhead.

- Each competitor or DUO couple must pay 150 euros for the participation in the tournament

The amounts must be paid to the Organizing Committee, at the latest, on the deadline indicated in the invitation.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION :

Start of the registration : **22 March 2022**

Visa request (MUST with passport copies): **22 March 2022**

Final Entry and payment deadline (entry by names) : **15 April 2022**

Nations missing the registration deadline will not be allowed to participate.

No exceptions will be made!

NOTE: It will be allowed to replace already registered coaches or officials; competitors only in the case of an injury.

6. CONTROL OF ENTRIES AND ACCREDITATION

Athletes must be presented and registered by their National Federation.

The control of entries and issuing of accreditation cards will take place :

On 22nd April 2022 from 17:00 to 19:00 for jujitsu fighting, Duo CLASSIC and SHOW and Jiu Jitsu : at Institut du Judo (Dojo - 21/25 avenue de la Porte de Châtillon – 75014 PARIS, France)

At least one team official must attend in time to confirm the entries of all athletes and officials with his/her signature. A delayed appearance or no-show at control of entries may result in the exclusion of all participants from the draw and the event. In case of unforeseen delay of arrival the Federation must contact immediately the organizer and the JJIF. An accreditation card will be issued to competitors, officials and media. This accreditation card should be carried at all times.

Passports or photocopy of passports from all competitors must be available on request.

Number of accreditations for coaches :

- a) 1 – 4 athletes : 4 coaches
- b) 5 – 9 athletes : 6 coaches
- c) 10 athletes : 7 coaches
- d) 11 – 20 athletes : 8 coaches
- e) and more than 20 athletes : 9 coaches

Age : athletes 18 years old and older are allowed to participate in ADULTS.

a. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest JJIF refereeing rules

- Women: -45kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg

c. Duration of contest :

Jujitsu Fighting (individual) : 3 minutes

Jui Jitsu : 6 minutes

9. REFEREES

The organising committee will take care of the referees working in this event, which means booking flights and hotel and transportation will be handled and covered by OC.

Application: Referees can register via SportsID for the event : https://www.sportdata.org/ju-jitsu/set-online/veranstaltung_info_main.php?active_menu=calendar&vern=340#a_eventhead.

All referees will be waitlisted first. The Technical Commission (Head referee of Discipline) will decide about participation in consideration of Discipline [s], Availability, License level, Evaluation and Ranking, Gender equality aspects, country. Continental and age mix.

10. WEIGH-IN

The athlete's official weigh-in will be scheduled the day before the competition (see previsionnal program)

Friday :

- Official weigh-in: 19:00 to 20:00

Saturday:

- Unofficial weigh-in: 15:00 to 16:00
- Official weigh-in: 16:00 to 17:00

11. DRAW

a. The draw will be conducted :

on 22nd april 2022 : at **20:30. Place : Dojo Institut du Judo**

on 23rd april 2022 : at **20:30. Place : Dojo Institut du Judo**

b. Each National Federation must send at least one delegate to attend the draw. A maximum of three (3) delegates per National Federation will be authorized.

12. JUDOGI (JUJITSUGI) CONTROL

Approved judogi : competitors should wear an JJIF approved judogi/jujitsugi of white color without patch.

13. PARTICULAR RULES FOR WOMEN

Female contestants shall wear under the jacket either, a round necked plain white or off-white rush guard, with short sleeves, made of non-rigid material, long enough to be worn inside the trousers, or a plain white or off-white leotard with short sleeves. No marking should be visible when the ju-jitsugi is done up. All other regulations must be adhered to.

14. COACHING

Code of behavior of coaches as defined JJIF Organization Rules, will be strictly observed, inclusive the Dress Code.

The trainers as whom the athletes are qualified for the final phases (places of 3rd and finales), will have to wear a proper clothing (dress code).

During the phases eliminating heats bermuda shorts or cap is forbidden. The trainers will have to wear a national track suit.

15. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping control can take place during the competition.



16. VISA

The Organizer is happy to help any country with obtaining visa for athletes and officials. For nations, who need VISA to enter FRANCE, please send the Organizer as soon as possible (latest March, 30th) list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of birth, and positions.

17. FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLE

All National Federations, officials, coaches and athletes participating in the JUJITSU GRAND SLAM PARIS 2022 have to respect and accept the authority of the JJIF officials, the Statutes, the Sports and Organization Rules, the Refereeing Rules of the International Jujitsu Federation, as well as the WADA (World Anti Doping Agency) rules.

18. ATTENTION VERY IMPORTANT

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses, shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation.

According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person.

19. COVID PROTOCOL

Since March 14, the "vaccination pass" has been suspended until further notice in all places where it was required (recreation and cultural venues, commercial catering activities, fairs and trade shows...).

Effective February 12, 2022, the following border rules will apply:

For travellers vaccinated in accordance with European regulations, no test will be required at departure. Evidence of a complete vaccination regimen is once again sufficient to arrive in France, regardless of the country of origin, as was the case before the Omicron variant was released.

For unvaccinated travellers, the requirement to submit a negative test to travel to France remains, but measures on arrival (test, isolation) are lifted when they come from countries on the “green” list, characterized by moderate circulation of the virus.







When unvaccinated travellers come from an “orange” list country, they will continue to have to present a compelling reason for their need, must present a negative PCR test to come to metropolitan France and may still be subject to a random test upon arrival. Travellers who are tested positive will be required to self-isolate as recommended by Medicare.

Depending on the evolution of the pandemic and government direction, the program will be adapted and announced in an upcoming announcement.
